Mr. Cooper noted that due to our available parking currently there may not be many options but it was a good idea. We need a little more information of how this would work and how the club would go about offering it.

Old Business

Still a topic for old business is the need for more involvement in the Gridiron Club. The Gridiron is looking to find a way to reach out to upcoming parents and even existing parents within the Canfield Football Athletic program. A question was asked about what the club could do in an effort to require

The Bowling Green Coaching staff will be making the presentation. Pav and the coaches are looking forward to learning as much as they can at these clinics and help our Football team thru another successful season.
